2. Artwork can be dropped off at Project Horizon, 120 Varner Lane, no later than May 27 from 8 am to 5 pm.
3. The exhibition will run throughout the month of June at Nelson Gallery, open Wednesday-Saturday from 11 am to 5 pm.
4. A Juneteenth Reception will be held at the Nelson Gallery on Friday, June 3rd 2022 from 5 pm to 7 pm.
5. A 20% sales commission fee should be factored into the sale price.
6. All pieces must be ready-to-hang, please use wires if possible (no claw hooks).
7. Due to space limitations, artists are limited to 2 submissions. **If you are interested in participating, please notify Project Horizon by email at [amullis@rockbridge.net](mailto:amullis@rockbridge.net) by May 27, 2022.**
